Mass Vaccination Drive in UK - a positive sign for students


Giving hope to International students, UK initiated vaccination drive which brings more students forward to move to UK for further studies; 21% students resume their study abroad plans as per a survey released by higher education company, Quacquarelli Symonds (QS).

Furthermore, the UK government confirms that the students will not be charged to apply for testing or treatment for Covid-19. While the order was placed for 40 million doses, the country has gained access to 357 million vaccine doses through multiple developers making UK to maintain its top position as the perfect choice for international students.



UK creating history

Accepting the recommendation from Medicines and Healthcare products Regulatory Authority (MHRA) to approve the
vaccination, UK hereby, becomes the first country to license a
Covid-19 vaccine. The country has procured 355 million vaccine
doses from seven different companies. The government also
confirms free testing or treatment in relation to Covid-19 for international students. Also, they will be able to access the vaccine just as any other healthcare facility. It is required for every
person to have 2 doses of this vaccine for full immunity wherein there should be a gap of 20 days in both the doses resulting
in person securing full immunity on the 28th day.

Compare something (to/with something)

The graph compares the death rates in India and the US.

Compared to/with something

Men's income rose by 31 % compared to only 13% for women.

in comparison (to/with something)

US workers get very little holiday in comparison with their European counterparts.

(draw/make) a comparison between two things

There is no comparison between my life here and the way of life in my home village.

Something is bigger/higher/lower/more important, etc. than something else

Kerala has more temples than any other Indian city.

Something is double/half, etc. that of something else

China's population density is double that of India.
